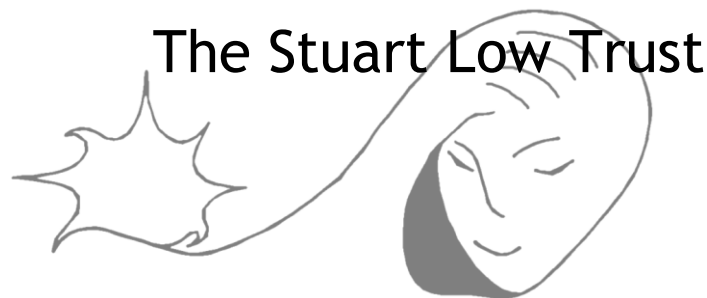

- be a valued member of The Stuart Low Trust team
- be invited to regular kitchen team meetings
- be invited to regular volunteer get togethers
- have individual support available
- be eligible for a reference from The Stuart Low Trust

Qualities we are looking for include:

- Willingness to be part of a team
- Ability to arrive punctually in time to start serving hot drinks, then food at 6.30pm
- A mature, courteous and professional disposition
- Feeling confident in asking participants what choice of food/drink they would like
- Willingness to help clear up afterwards (we use paper cups/plates, so minimal washing up)
- An awareness of mental health issues
- It would be desirable to have previous volunteering experience, but not essential
- A sense of humour and an ability to stay calm and centred
- Willingness to abide by The Stuart Low Trust Code of Conduct
